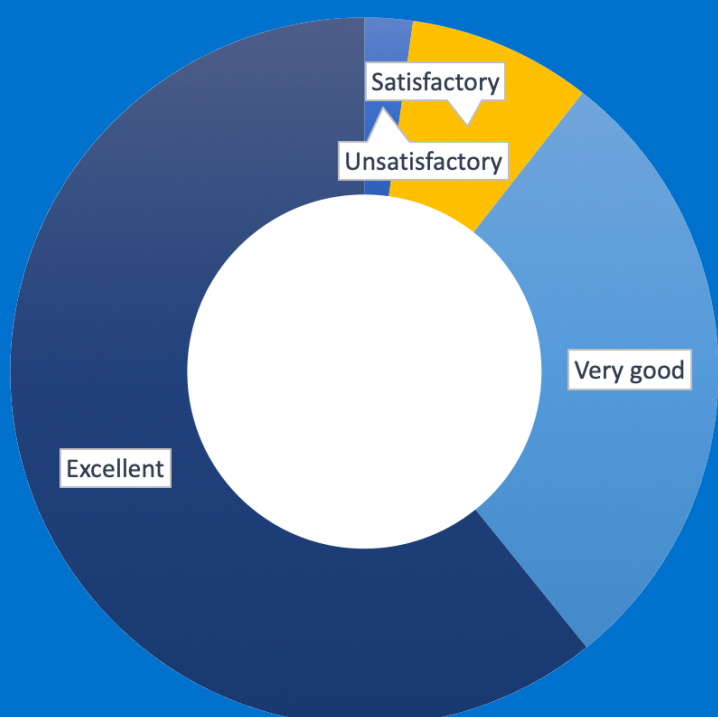


2021 Virtual Summer Abroad Survey Summary

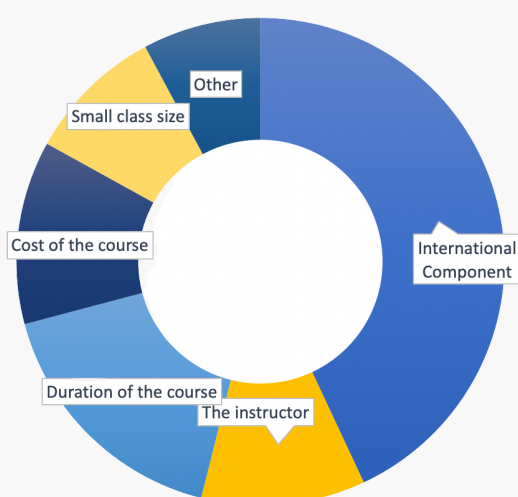

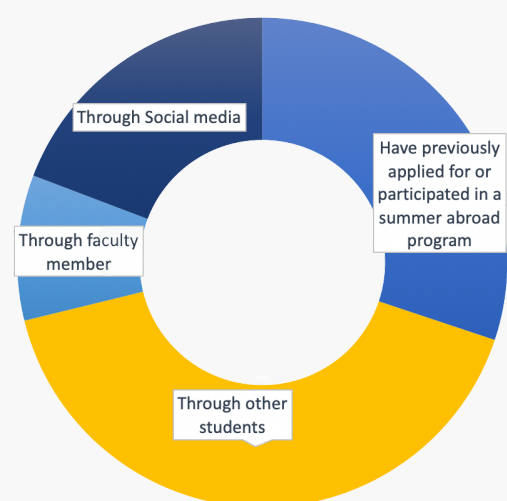

For 2021, the majority (60.79%) of our participants rated their overall Summer Abroad experience as 'Excellent', while 28.63% rated 'Very Good' and 8.37% rated 'Satisfactory'

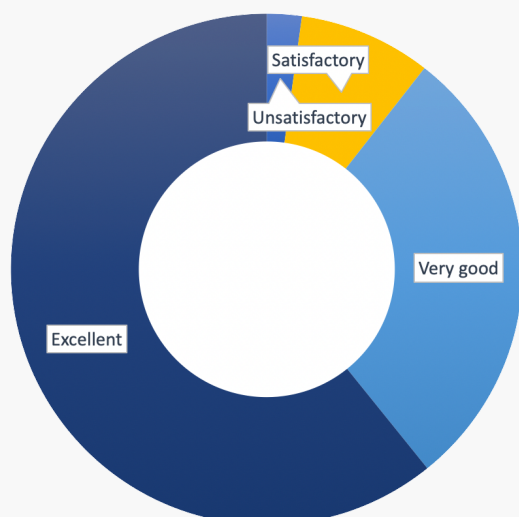

Most of our participants heard of our Summer Abroad programs through other students, and/or have applied for the summer abroad in the past, and/or through social media.



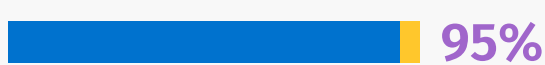
Over 60% of participants think the virtual program activities are excellent! 97% of participants are satisfied with the virtual program activities for the 2021 Virtual Summer Abroad.

2021 Virtual Summer Abroad Survey Summary



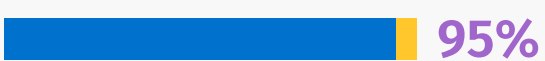
95% of participants said that the virtual summer abroad experience provided an opportunity to develop skills that will help them progress through their academic program.
